The Central Dakota Human Resources Association (CDHRA) in coordination with the Bismarck Public Schools Career Academy will be hosting its 3<sup>rd</sup> annual mock interview event November 22 <sup>nd</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

This event brings together nearly 50 volunteers to provide mock interviews to over 150 health science and other vocational tech students at the Career Academy.
